The Gospel Message

Why should I and how can I have eternal life through Jesus Christ?

Everyone has sinned against God - Romans 3:23 KJV "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God"

Consequences of one's sin is death - Romans 6:23 KJV "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

God's answer for our sin problem is sending Jesus Christ - Romans 5:8 KJV "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us"

God is calling you to a personal relationship with Him - Revelation 3:20 KJV "Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me."

Receive Christ by faith (trusting) in Jesus Christ as your Saviour - Romans 10:9 KJV "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved."

Romans 10:13 KJV "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved."

Results of being saved - Romans 8:1 KJV There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit." Romans 8:38-39 KJV "For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord."
